

1- Give me your son

1a Took him from her bosom (took sin/died on cross)

2a carried him into loft (out of sight/buried/loving contact with the dead)

3a laid him upon his own bed (minister/rose again on the 3rd day)

2-cried out unto Lord

Inquiring, not accusing God:

2a evil upon woman?

2b whom I sojourn

2c by slaying son?

3-stretched himself on child 3 times (establish loving contact with the dead)

3 cried unto the LORD

3 said : O Lord my God, I pray thee, let this child's soul come unto him again.

1-Then the LORD heard the voice of Elijah (prayer for the dead/Jesus prayed on cross)

2 The soul of the child came into him again

3- He revived

17:18 And she said unto Elijah, (Fleshly/AI mentality/not saved/lash out on Elijah)

1-What have I to do with thee, O thou man of God? (condemnation instead of justification through Jesus on the cross)

2-art though come unto me to call my sin to remembrance (sins not buried)

3- and to slay my son? (stay dead in sins, not risen, like Jesus)

17:19 He said unto her, Give me thy son (done through the power of the Gospel/Good News/contact with the spiritually dead, we all NEED TO HEAR WHAT JESUS DID. The ENTIRE GOOD NEWS)

1- And he took him out of her bosom, (Jesus can only give new life spiritually, He stretched His arms on the cross)

2- and carried him up into a loft, where he abode, (bury our sins forever, no remembrance)

3- and laid him upon his own bed. (still dead and hidden from mom, like Jesus was buried/not risen/no one saw Him in the tomb/buried, but God)

17:20 And He cried unto the LORD and said

1- My God, (like Jesus spoke on the cross saying “my God...” we also pray for others salvation, we have to cry out to Jesus ourselves to accept Him by faith that He died for your sins, was buried, and rose again on the third day)

2- hast though also brought evil upon the widow with whom I sojourn, (a reminder to us that Jesus was forsaken and took the evil sin of ours as a substitute in our place. At this time Elijah didn't experience the Gospel, but was an example of what was to come)

3- by slaying her son? (God sent His son Jesus to do the dying on the cross for our sins, was buried, and rose again on the third day.)

17:21

1- And he stretched himself upon the child three times. (Jesus stretched Himself on the cross once, buried once and rose again on the third day once).

2- and cried unto the Lord (Cry out once to accept the Good News by faith)

3-and said, O LORD my God, I pray thee, let this child's soul come again into him again. (we were dead spiritually and need revived to be alive spiritually, by faith in Jesus/LORD alone.)

17:22

1- The LORD heard the voice of Elijah (His prayer was heard)

2- and the soul of the child came into him again, (Elijah did those three steps and the dead child got his soul back, so he could be revived, can't be revived without hearing the 1-2-3 GOOD NEWS!!!)

3-and he revived (he rose like Jesus)

17:23

1-Elijah took child (Like God did a miracle in us through Jesus dying on the cross for our sins,)

2- brought him down out of chamber into the house, (we are now ready to be seen by others, not BURIED with our sins, a new creation)

3- delivered him unto his mother (we can be seen as different because Jesus died on the cross for our sins, was buried, and rose again on the third day, he did the work, we can not boast. What others can see was done miraculously in the unseen spiritual world. We are walking alive living proof!!!)

See, thy Son liveth

(people know we are not living for sins/death by us accepting the Gospel -being justified and sanctified. It wasn't a pitch, it wasn't a sign, it is hearing the GOODS NEWS that Jesus died on the cross for my sins, Jesus was buried, and Jesus rose again on the THIRD day!!!!!!!!)
